SEASON OVERVIEW

Thank you for choosing Titan Elite All Star Cheer...

As we head into the 2026-2027 season, our focus is to continue building a program that is structured, efficient, and centered around athlete development.

Throughout last season, we gathered valuable feedback from families regarding:

- The need for increased practice time
- More opportunities for skill development outside of team practices
- A desire for practices to feel more consistently structured and productive

We have taken this feedback seriously and have made intentional updates to improve both the quality and efficiency of training across the program.

Our goal this season is to ensure that athletes are:

- Maximizing their time in the gym
- Receiving consistent, focused instruction
- Actively engaged throughout the entirety of practice

By refining our training structure and expanding access to skill-based development, we are creating an environment that supports both individual growth and overall team success.

We are committed to continuing to evolve our program in ways that best support our athletes, our teams, and the overall experience at Titan Elite.



PROGRAM UPDATES

Mandatory Weekly Tumble Class

For the 2026-2027 season, we are expanding both training time and skill development opportunities across all Prep and Elite teams.

All Prep and Elite athletes will be required to attend a weekly tumble technique class, which is included in tuition. This class will focus on:

- Proper technique
- Strength and body control
- Skill progression and consistency

Participation in all required training components is essential to ensure athletes are progressing at the expected pace and contributing to team success.

Additional Skill Development Class

Athletes will also have the opportunity to enroll in an additional Next Level Training Classes designed for athletes who are looking to accelerate their progress.

This class will be offered at a discounted rate for Titan Elite athletes and will focus on:

- Advancing tumbling skills
- Individualized progressions
- Increased repetitions and corrections

This option is ideal for athletes who are looking to continue building and refining skills beyond the required training.

Updated Practice Structure

Practice structure will be more intentional this season to ensure athletes are actively engaged and maximizing their time in the gym.

Practices will include:

- Increased focus on skill-specific reps
- Reduced downtime during practices
- More efficient use of all training space

These updates are designed to create a more productive and focused training environment where athletes are consistently working and improving.

FLYER FLEXIBILITY

As part of our commitment to athlete development, Titan Elite requires all Elite flyers to participate in ongoing flexibility and body position training outside of regular practices.

Weekly Expectations

Elite flyers will be required to submit **weekly photos or videos** of assigned body positions through the Band App.

Submissions will be used to:

- Track progress throughout the season
- Reinforce proper technique and positioning
- Ensure consistency outside of practice

Pre-Practice Preparation

Flyers are expected to take responsibility for preparing their bodies prior to practice.

Whenever possible, athletes should plan to arrive **approximately 15-20 minutes early** to:

- Stretch
- Warm up body positions
- Prepare for stunting

We understand that some athletes may be coming directly from school or other commitments. However, consistent pre-practice preparation plays a significant role in both performance and injury prevention.

Accountability

Athletes who consistently prioritize flexibility training—both in and out of practice—will be better positioned for success in stunt groups and routines.

Lack of preparation may impact:

- Stunt positions
- Routine placement
- Overall performance opportunities

Purpose

Flexibility, strength, and body control are essential for successful stunting at all levels.

Training these skills **only during practice is not sufficient** to maintain and improve performance. Consistent work outside of practice allows athletes to:

- Improve flexibility
- Maintain stability in the air
- Execute skills with proper technique and confidence

Additional Training

This season, Titan Elite will be offering **flyer flexibility classes** designed to further develop strength, control, and body positions.

While not required, these classes are **highly recommended** for athletes who want to continue progressing and improving their performance in the air.

TOTAL TRAINING STRUCTURE

Total Training Structure

With these updates, athletes will now have multiple opportunities each week to train, develop skills, and improve performance.

For Prep and Elite athletes, weekly training will include:

- Team Practices (choreography, stunting, routine work)
- Required Tumble Technique Class (included in tuition)

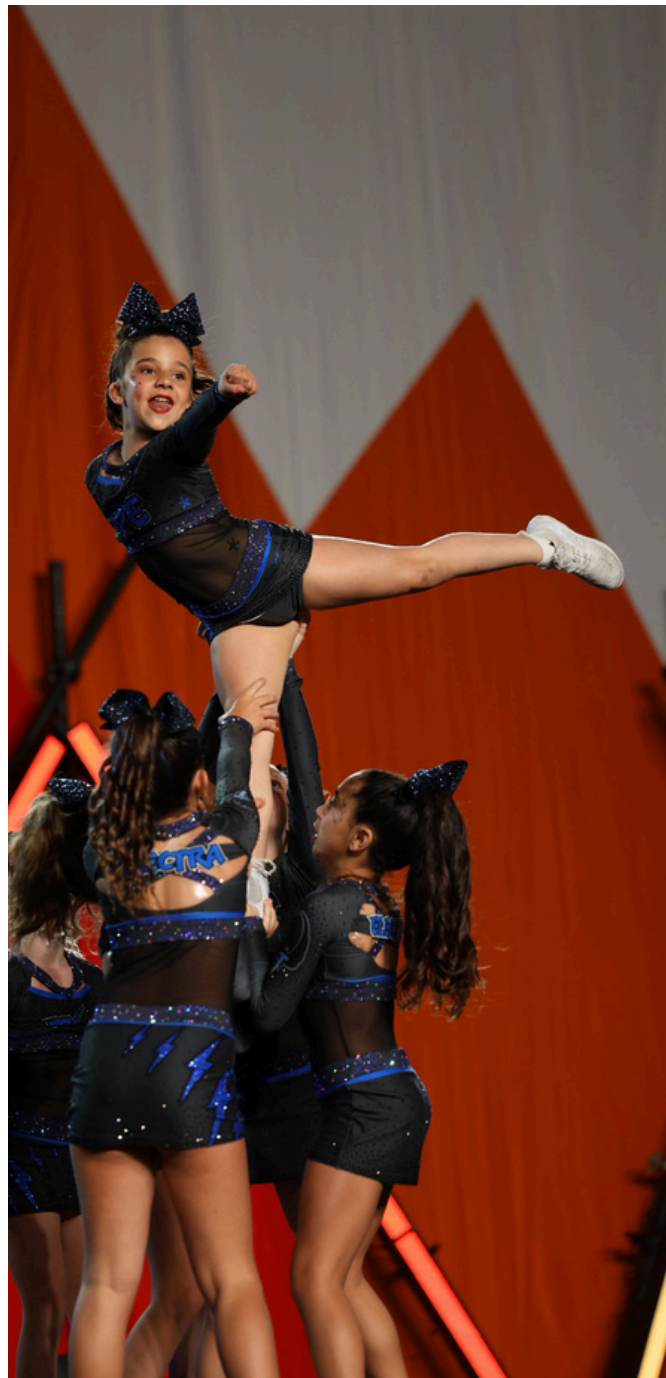
Participation in all required training components is essential to ensure athletes are progressing at the expected pace and contributing to team success

- Optional Skill Development Class (discounted, for accelerated progress)

This structure allows athletes to:

- Build and refine skills outside of routine time
- Maximize repetitions and corrections
- Continue progressing throughout the season

These updates are designed to provide a more complete training experience and better prepare athletes for both individual growth and competitive success.



TEAM REVEAL

Following evaluations and leveled practices, athletes will receive their official team placement at Team Reveal.

Each athlete will receive a Team Reveal Envelope containing all necessary information to begin the season. This will include:

- **Team Placement**

The team your athlete has been selected for for the 2026-2027 season

- **Practice Schedule**

Days and times for all weekly team practices

- **Tumble Level (New for this season)**

Each athlete will be assigned a tumble level, which will determine placement in required and optional tumbling classes

- **Class Recommendations**

Guidance on additional classes that may support your athlete's development

- **Stunt Camp Schedule**

Dates and times for required stunt camp training sessions

- **Choreography Schedule**

Dates and times for all choreography sessions-Full attendance is required for all choreography sessions.

- **Tentative Competition Schedule (if available)**

A preliminary outline of competition dates and locations. Please note that this schedule is subject to change until finalized.

- **Season Details & Next Steps**

Information on upcoming practices, required events, and important dates

The addition of tumble levels allows us to provide more targeted instruction and ensure athletes are training at an appropriate level for growth and consistency.

Tumble levels will be assigned based on:

- Current skill ability
- Execution and consistency
- Readiness for progression

Levels may be adjusted throughout the season as athletes continue to develop.

SEASON CALENDAR

The following dates provide a general outline of the 2026–2027 season. This schedule is intended to help families plan ahead and understand the overall flow of the season. All dates are subject to change. Additional details and updates will be communicated throughout the season.

Pre-Season

- Evaluations: May 26–29
- Leveled Practices: June 1–11
- Team Reveal: June 12
- Mandatory Parent Meeting: (TBD)

Summer Training

- Stunt Camp (Mandatory): June 29–July 3
- Summer Practices Begin: June 15
- Choreography Week (Mandatory): August 9–15

In-Season

- Fall Practices Begin: September 8
- Program Showcase: Early/Mid December (TBD)

Competition Season

- Competition Season: December – April
- End of Season Events (Summit, etc.): April – May

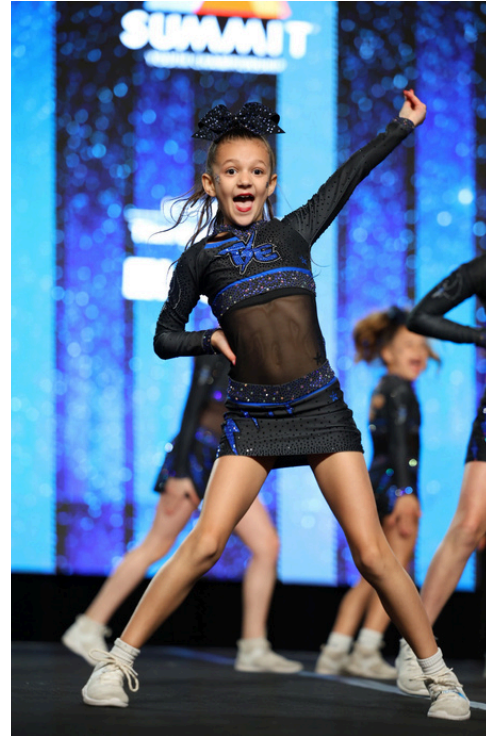
A full competition schedule will be released on or around September 1.

Breaks and Closures

- Holiday Break: Late December – Early January (TBD)
- Spring Break: April (TBD)

Important Notes

- All practices, camps, choreography sessions, and competitions are considered mandatory unless otherwise specified
- Athletes are permitted (3) unexcused absences from September 1 through the end of the season
- Please refer to the Attendance Policy in the Titan Elite Handbook for full details
- Additional practices may be added throughout the season, especially leading up to competitions
- Families are expected to plan vacations and commitments around team obligations.



COMPETITIONS

Competitions are a central part of the All Star experience and provide athletes with the opportunity to perform and showcase their progress. All competition attendance requirements and policies are outlined in the Titan Elite Handbook.

A full competition schedule will be released on or around September 1.

Competition schedules are subject to change

Estimated Competition Schedule

- Elite Teams: Approximately 6–7 competitions, plus an end-of-season event
- Prep Teams: Approximately 5–6 competitions
- Novice Teams: Approximately 4–5 competitions

Scheduling & Flexibility

Competition times, locations, and formats are determined by event producers and may change. Titan Elite is not responsible for any costs associated with flight changes, hotel changes, schedule adjustments.

Families are strongly encouraged to book flexible or refundable travel options when possible. Competition schedules and performance times can change, and Titan Elite is not responsible for any costs associated with booking changes.

TRAVEL & TRANSPORTATION

All travel arrangements, including flights, hotels, and transportation, are the responsibility of the athlete's family.

For travel competitions, athletes are expected to:

- Follow all team itineraries
- Arrive and depart according to team schedules
- Be present for all required practices and team activities

For two-day events, families should plan to arrive no later than Friday evening.

Hotel blocks will be provided when available, and families must follow stay-to-play requirements when applicable.

Coaches Fees

Certain competitions, particularly those requiring travel, may include additional coaches fees. These fees will be communicated in advance once event details are finalized.

END OF SEASON EVENTS



End of Season Events

End-of-season (EOS) events are the culminating competitions for our teams and may include:

- **D2 Summit (Junior/Senior Elite Teams)**
- **Youth Summit (Youth Elite Teams)**
- **Regional Summit (Prep Teams)**

These events are earned through bids received at competitions throughout the season.

Registration Payments

Once a team earns a bid:

- Families will be provided with registration instructions and deadlines
- Registration and event selections will be completed directly through Varsity (when applicable)

Please note:

- Payment timelines are determined by Varsity and are **strictly enforced**
- Bids may be awarded at any point between **December and April**
- Families should be financially prepared to commit within a short timeframe

Travel Requirements

Many end-of-season events are **Stay-to-Play events**.

This means:

- Hotels must be booked through designated housing providers (ex: Team Travel Source)
- Families must follow all housing and booking requirements set by the event

Hotel information and booking links will be shared as soon as they become available.

Additional EOS Fees

In addition to event registration, Titan Elite may collect additional fees related to:

- Coaches fees
- Additional practices or facility use
- Practice wear or team items

These fees are typically collected between **March and April**, depending on when bids are received.

Important Considerations

- Earning a bid is an achievement, but participation requires a **financial and time commitment**
- Families should plan ahead for the possibility of attending an EOS event
- Final decisions regarding attendance must align with program expectations and deadlines

POSTSEASON DEVELOPMENT PHASE

For the 2026–2027 season, Titan Elite will be introducing a postseason development phase for select teams. This phase is designed to provide athletes with an opportunity to continue training, build new skills, and prepare for the upcoming season in a structured and intentional way.

Novice Teams

Following their final competition in March, Novice teams will continue training throughout April.

During this time, athletes will focus on:

- Skill progression
- Strength and technique development
- Introduction to higher-level elements

Athletes will learn and perform a “leveled up” routine, which will be showcased at the Regional Summit Showcase.

This allows athletes to:

- Experience growth beyond their competitive season
- Build confidence in new skills
- Better prepare for advancement into Prep teams

Prep Teams (If Applicable)

Prep teams may also participate in a postseason development phase following their final competition.

This phase will focus on:

- Continued skill development
- Increased difficulty in tumbling and stunting
- Preparation for Elite-level expectations

Prep athletes will work toward a leveled up routine, which may be performed at a postseason showcase event, such as a D2 Summit Showcase.

Final details for Prep participation will be communicated during the season.

Important Notes

- This phase is considered part of the season and will follow regular attendance expectations
- Training will be focused on development rather than competition routines
- This is an opportunity for athletes to continue progressing and preparing for the next level

Our goal is not just to finish a season, but to prepare athletes for what comes next.

FINANCIAL BREAKDOWN

Financial Overview

Participation in Titan Elite includes both monthly tuition and additional seasonal fees. This structure allows costs to be distributed throughout the year while covering all aspects of training, competitions, and program operations.

Leveled Practice Fee (June)

Leveled practices will take place from June 1-11, followed by Team Reveal on June 12.

All athletes will participate in the same training schedule and will be evaluated by the full Titan Elite coaching staff.

Leveled Practice Fee:

\$165 per athlete

This fee covers:

- All leveled practice sessions
- Athlete evaluation and team placement
- The transition into team practices beginning the week of June 15

Leveled practices are designed to evaluate each athlete's skill level, consistency, and readiness in order to build the most competitive teams possible.

Monthly Tuition Rates

- *Elite Teams:* \$260/month
- *Prep Teams:* \$235/month
- *Novice Teams (Mini/Youth):* \$200/month
- *Tiny Novice:* \$190/month

Tuition is charged monthly from July through April.

Monthly Tuition

Monthly tuition covers all regularly scheduled training and required program components throughout the season.

Tuition Includes:

- Team practices
- Required weekly tumble technique class (new for this season)
- Registration and insurance
- Music
- Postseason Development Phase (April training)

This fee does not include in season coaches fee(new this season). The coaches fee is now included in Competition Fee Installments.

Training Structure (what tuition includes)

Training schedules vary by program level:

- Elite Teams: 2 practices per week, 2 hours per practice
- Prep Teams: 2 practices per week, 1.5 hours per practice
- Mini/Youth Novice: 2 practices per week, 1 hour per practice
- Tiny Novice: 1 practice per week, 1 hour per practice

All Prep and Elite athletes are also required to attend a weekly tumble technique class, which is included in tuition.

FINANCIAL BREAKDOWN

Postseason Development Phase

Postseason Development Phase (April training) is included in tuition. Please refer to the Postseason Development Phase section for full details.

Season Fees (Installments)

Additional season fees cover costs that are paid directly to third-party vendors and events. These fees are not included in monthly tuition.

These include:

- Stunt camp and choreography sessions
- Choreography fees
- Competition entry fees
- Coaches fees for in-season competitions

These fees will be split into multiple installments and charged throughout the season (July-January).

All fees are estimates and may fluctuate slightly based on actual costs.

FINANCIAL BREAKDOWN

Uniform & Apparel

Uniform and apparel costs are separate from tuition and are due upon ordering.

Estimated costs:

- Elite Uniform: ~\$625
- Prep/Novice Uniform: ~\$300
- Practice Wear: ~\$150
- Sneakers: ~\$115
- Hair Accessory: ~\$35

Payment deadlines:

- Uniform & practice wear: August 15
- Sneakers & hair accessory: October 1

Crossover Fees (If Applicable)

Athletes invited to compete on multiple teams will incur additional costs.

- Crossover Tuition: \$40/month
- Additional Competition Fees: ~400
- Additional Choreography Fee: ~\$100

End of Season Events

End-of-season events are not included in regular season fees. These events are earned through bids at competitions. Estimated costs include registration, coaches fees, and travel.

Payment Structure

Fees are distributed throughout the season to make payments more manageable.

A detailed payment schedule will be provided outlining all due dates, including:

- Monthly tuition
- Installments
- Apparel payments
- Competition fees

Our pricing structure reflects the level of training, coaching, and opportunities provided to each athlete throughout the season.

Optional Expenses

Optional items may include:

- Backpack (~\$120)
- Warm-up jacket (~\$100)
- Additional skill/tumble classes

These items are not required and will be offered throughout the season.

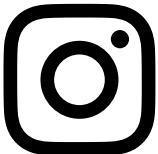
